

## ***“Powertex Silk paper” exclusive collection (20g) 34x49 cm.***



**Materials:** Silk paper, Easycoat Mat, water, spray bottle, two wide flat brushes, one to use dry

### ***Method for Silk paper in small peaces.***

- . Tear or cut the paper (watering it makes it more transparant).
- . Smear your surface evenly with Easycoat Mat.
- . Put the paper (wet or dry) onto the layer of Easycoat.
- . Press the paper onto the surface with a flat dry brush (begin in the middle).
- . Let dry and finish with a layer of Easycoat.

### ***Method to secure Silk paper in one peace (or larger peaces) on a canvas or other surface.***

- . Put your paper face down on a smooth surface, preferably a solid plastic film or a large piece of greaseproof paper.
- . Use a spray bottle to carefully wet with some water.
- . Smear your canvas or surface with Easy coat Mat.
- . Carefully place the greaseproof paper on the surface (face up) and smoothen with the palm of your hand.
- . Take the greaseproof paper away. Gently push the Silk paper onto the canvas or surface with a dry wide flat brush, start from the middle. Briefly let it dry.
- . Reapply the greaseproof paper and iron with a flatiron on the lowest setting.
- . End with a layer of Easycoat or other medium of your choice. Finish with materials of your choice.
